Mark was appointed Executive Director & Secretary of The Royal Warrant Holders Association in February 2020. Formerly, he had been Private Secretary to the then H.R.H. The Prince of Wales.

During his 15 years at Clarence House, he held a range of responsibilities, but throughout had a core portfolio comprising Health, Education and H.R.H.'s interests in Scotland. As Private Secretary, he managed the Private Office working closely with other senior members of The Royal Household.

Prior to joining The Prince of Wales's Household, Mark held senior roles in BBC management including Corporate Affairs, Governance and Public Policy. His earlier background saw him appointed to editorial posts in local and national newspapers and commercial radio, before joining the BBC as a senior presenter in News and Current Affairs.

Mark has held a number of Charitable Trustee roles and was a Director of a San Francisco-based family foundation.

He was made a Commander of the Victorian Order (C.V.O.) in The Queen's Birthday Honours list in 2017.
